## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN APPROVING A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION (Railroad Safety Fencing)

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin's Environmental Coordinator has reviewed the Railroad Safety Fencing ("Project") and determined that it is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to California Code of Regulations Section 15303 – New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures and 15311 - Accessory Structures; and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Exemption has been prepared for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Based on the review and determination of the Environmental Coordinator, the City Council of the City of Rocklin finds that the Project is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act.

<u>Section 2</u>. A Notice of Exemption is approved for the Project.

<u>Section 3</u>. Upon approval of the Project by the City Council, the Environmental Coordinator may file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk of Placer County and, if the Project requires a discretionary approval from any state agency, with the State Office of Planning and Research, pursuant to the provisions of Section 21152(b) of the Public Resources Code and the State EIR Guidelines adopted pursuant thereto.

Reasons why the project is exempt. The project involves the construction of Railroad Safety Fencing along the railroad tracks that parallel Front Street in the City of Rocklin, as further described above. Class 3 exemptions consist of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. The numbers of structures described in this section are the maximum allowable on any legal parcel. Examples of this exemption include, but are not limited to: (e) Accessory (appurtenant) structures including garages, carports, patios, swimming pools, and fences. Class 11 exemptions consist of construction or placement of minor structures accessory to (appurtenant to) existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities. The project as proposed is consistent with the exemption class descriptions noted above and is exempt pursuant to Classes 3 and 11 of the CEQA Guidelines.
