RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
APPROVING PACIFIC STREET AT ROCKLIN ROAD ROUNDABOUT DESIGN CONCEPT AND AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO MOVE FORWARD WITH RIGHTS OF WAY DISCUSSIONS AND NEGOTIATIONS
WITH PROPERTY OWNERS IN PREPARATION FOR PROPERTY ACQUISITION UPON ENVIRONMENTAL
APPROVAL

The City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Pacific Street at Rocklin Road Roundabout Project is currently undergoing an extended environmental review that is anticipated to be completed by the Caltrans Headquarters, Cultural Studies Office (CSO) in mid to late October, 2019; and

WHEREAS the City cannot receive Federal/State authorization to proceed, finalize the design plan, purchase rights of way, or start the bidding process until the environmental review has been completed and approved by the CSO; and

WHEREAS, approving the design concept and authorizing the City Manager to conduct discussions and negotiations related to rights of way acquisition will allow staff to prepare to immediately move forward once the environmental review is complete; and

WHEREAS, there is no fiscal impact associated with this resolution and no budget appropriation is necessary; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Rocklin hereby approves the Pacific Street at Rocklin Road Roundabout Design Concept and Authorizes the City Manager to Move Forward with Rights of Way Discussions and Negotiations with Property Owners in Preparation for Property Acquisition upon Environmental Approval.
