RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL EXTENDING THE TERM FOR APPOINTMENTS TO THE CITY OF
ROCKLIN'S LOCAL BOARD AND COMMISSION RECRUITMENTS
FROM JUNE 2020 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2020

WHEREAS, the City Council has established Boards and Commissions to review City programs, projects, and community issues. These Boards and Commissions provide greater community participation and input into local government and facilitate informed decisions by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, City of Rocklin Board and Commission members serve a four-year term and are appointed to serve from July 1st through June 30th, with the Youth Commission member serving one-year term, appointed to serve from July 1st through June 30th; and

WHEREAS, the City traditionally begins the recruitment process for Board and Commission members in April with interviews and appointments approved by Council in June; and

WHEREAS, due to the recent outbreak of the Coronavirus, the California Govern's stay at home order issued on March 19, 2020, and the on-going recommendation from public health authorities for those at higher risk of severe illness stay at home if possible, it was not practicable to start the recruitment process in April for appointments to various City Boards and Commissions in June; and

WHEREAS, thorough recruitment efforts are necessary to encourage a diverse and qualified group of community members serve on the city's various boards and commissions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The term of appointment for members of the Board of Appeals, Community Recognition Commission, Parks, Recreation and Arts Commission, and the Planning Commission expiring on June 30, 2020 are hereby extended to September 30, 2020, as identified in Exhibit A attached hereto.
