



Evaluation Criteria

- **Build Ready-** two acres of land to support construction of a pump track and additional amenities.
- Visibility- enhances park user's comfort and security.
- Existing amenity access- existing amenities (restrooms, water fountains and parking) within a reasonable distance.
- Parking- adequate parking for visitors and possible large events.
- **Project Funding-** funding available to support the project.
- Bike Access proximity to bike paths and bike lanes.




Whitney Community Park

Pros

- Undeveloped area provides space for pump track and additional park development
- Funding through NW Rocklin Community Park Fund
- Safe bike access
- Visibility / Safety

- Proximity of existing restrooms and water fountains
- Additional parking needed during periods of high demand





Twin Oaks Community Park

Pros

- Parking near potential build site
- Undeveloped area provides enough space for pump track construction

- Visibility / Safety
- Safe bike access
- Proximity of existing restrooms and water fountains
- Uses most of existing undeveloped park space
- Dedicated funding source







Margaret Azevedo Community Park
