RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN APPROVING THE STREAMBED ALTERATION AGREEMENT FOR ROUTINE MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin performs routine maintenance activities within California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) jurisdictional areas to maintain functional and structural integrity of City facilities with the ultimate goal of flood protection; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California State Fish and Game Code Section 1600, et seq., a Streambed Alteration Agreement (Agreement) is required to perform work within CDFW jurisdictional areas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin's previous Agreement with CDFW has expired and City staff worked with CDFW to update and revise the Agreement to reflect current guidelines and policies; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is for twelve years with one optional five year extension for a possible total of seventeen years; and

WHEREAS, a Mitigated Negative Declaration of Environmental Impact and Mitigation Monitoring Program was adopted by the City Council of the City of Rocklin on August 11, 2020, Resolution 2020-152 for this project; and

WHEREAS, there is no additional fiscal impact as the divisions/departments will use previously approved budgeted amounts to cover associated costs with this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows;

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Council approves the Streambed Alteration Agreement for Routine Maintenance Activities.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife for the Streambed Alteration Agreement for Routine Maintenance Activities in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
- <u>Section 3.</u> The City Manager is authorized to extend the agreement for one additional five year period.
