RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE WINDING LANE CURVE & LOST AVENUE INTERSECTION
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO CENTRAL VALLEY ENGINEERING AND ASPHALT, INC. AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Winding Lane Curve & Lost Avenue Intersection Improvement Project consists of widening the roadway along the curve at Winding Lane to expand the roadway to meet current City standards; and install curb, sidewalk, and gutter at the intersection of Lost Avenue and Winding Lane; and

WHEREAS, the invitation for bids on the Project was advertised on June 11, 2021, and June 18, 2021, with bids opened on June 22, 2021, examined and found to be in compliance with all applicable specifications; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid was determined to be \$312,775, submitted by Central Valley Engineering and Asphalt, Inc., and staff recommends the contract for Project be awarded to Central Valley Engineering and Asphalt, Inc; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Rocklin Municipal Code, section 3.04.050, a contingency amount of fifteen percent of the contract (\$46,917 (rounded)), is automatically authorized for all public works project contracts awarded by the City Council or the City manager, as long as adequate funds have been appropriated, bringing the total authorized Project amount to \$359,692 (rounded); and

WHEREAS, this project is included in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021/22 budget approved by the City Council of the City of Rocklin and is funded using SB325 Gas Tax Funds (210); and

WHEREAS, a budget appropriation is necessary to source additional funding from the SB325 Gas Tax Fund (210) in the amount of \$53,652.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

Section 1. The City Council awards the contract for the Winding Lane Curve & Lost Avenue Intersection Improvement Project to Central Valley Engineering and Asphalt, Inc. in the amount of \$312,775.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement with Central Valley Engineering and Asphalt, Inc. for the Project, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Rocklin authorizes a budget appropriation in the amount of \$53,652 from the SB325 Gas Tax Fund (210).
