RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN APPROVING THE COOPERATIVE FIRE PROGRAMS LOCAL RESPONSIBILITY AREA WILDLAND PROTECTION REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY AND FIRE PROTECTION (CAL FIRE) FOR WILDLAND FIRE PROTECTION WITHIN THE CLOVER VALLEY LAKES AREA FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) has the ability to provide wildland fire protection within the Clover Valley Lakes area of the City of Rocklin, and the City desires to contract with CAL FIRE to provide this service as long as portions of the Clover Valley Lakes area remains undeveloped; and

WHEREAS, in 1997, pursuant to Resolution 97-311, the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute an agreement with CAL FIRE for wildland fire protection with no dollar amount specified; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2003-276, the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute an annual wildland fire protection agreement for the Clover Valley Lakes area with CAL FIRE, providing a cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2004-105, and in accordance with Exhibit A to Resolution No. 2004-105, the developer of Clover Valley Lakes area entered into a reimbursement agreement to reimburse the City for the cost of CAL FIRE wildland protection service. The agreement remains in effect for as long as CAL FIRE provides protection of wildlands within the annexation territory; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2021-40, an amended agreement with CAL FIRE for fiscal year 2020/2021 included a reduction in the total protection cost for 613.2 acres. The updated acreage correction was determined per the Placer County Assessor's Office.

WHEREAS, the Operating Plan submitted with the CAL FIRE agreement (Exhibit A) provides the City with wildland fire protection and would cover the expenses of a wildland fire response; and in the absence of contract coverage through CAL FIRE, the City would be responsible to pay for CAL FIRE response costs; and

WHEREAS, the current CAL FIRE agreement cost calculations for 613.2 acres is approximately \$23,043.66 for Fiscal Year 2021/2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The annual Cooperative Fire Programs Local Responsibility Area Wildland Protection Reimbursement Agreement with the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) for wildland fire protection within the Clover Valley Lakes area of the City

of Rocklin for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 is approved in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and the City Manager is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
