RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
OF INTENT TO INITIATE AMENDMENTS TO THE ROCKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17 ZONING,
REGARDING DESIGN REVIEW AND STAFF APPROVALS OF EXPANSIONS FOR OUTDOOR DINING

The City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Rocklin finds and determines that Title 17 of the Rocklin Municipal Code which collectively regulates zoning requires updates to assist restaurants negatively affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. The changes will facilitate the creation of a temporary program that allows existing Rocklin restaurants to create permanent outdoor dining operations through an alternative design review entitlement process that utilizes staff-level approvals, saving applicants time and money.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs staff to prepare and process amendments to the Rocklin Municipal Code to address the specific items listed in Section 1, above.
