RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN STATING ITS INTENTION AND ORDERING TERRITORY DETACHED FROM ROCKLIN LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 (Cool Pools)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Division 15, Part 2 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, being known as the "Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972" (the "Act"), the City Council of the City of Rocklin has formed a district known as Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 (hereinafter referred to as "District No. 1"); and

WHEREAS, the territory that comprises that certain Subdivision known as Cool pools (the "Subdivision" or the "Territory"), as described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, is currently within District No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested the Territory be detached from District No. 1 and be annexed to Community Facilities District No. 5 for the purpose of maintaining street lighting and landscaping to be installed as part of the Subdivision's improvements; and

WHEREAS, under section 22605, et seq., of the Act, the detachment process shall be initiated, conducted and completed in the same manner as for the formation of a district; provided, that the required resolutions, report, notices, hearing, and right of majority protest shall be waived with the written consent of all of the owners of property within the Territory to be detached; and

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the Territory proposed to be detached have waived the resolutions, report, notices, hearing, and right of majority protest; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to detach the Territory from District No. 1 and the owner of all the Territory consents thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council of the City of Rocklin declares its intent to and hereby orders the detachment of the Territory from District No. 1.
