RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN AMENDING THE SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR CITY SERVICES TO INCLUDE NON-EMERGENCY LIFT ASSISTANCE FEES (RESO. 2021-192)

WHEREAS, through enactment of Rocklin Municipal Code Chapter 3.32, the City maintains a service fee cost comparison system for the purpose of recovering some or all of the costs reasonably borne of providing services of a voluntary and limited nature through fees for those services, so that general taxes are not diverted from general services of a broad nature and utilized instead to subsidize such services of limited benefit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rocklin Municipal Code Chapter 3.32, and newly enacted Chapter 9.50 establishing the non-emergency lift assistance fee for licensed care facilities, City staff has reviewed the costs for providing non-emergency lift assistance at licensed care facilities and recommended the Lift Assist fee be established in the amount of \$223; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution 2021-192 approving the Schedule of Fees for city services, and it is the intention of the City Council to amend the schedule of fees for Public Safety (Fire) to include a Lift Assist fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Rocklin adopts the Non-Emergency Lift Assistance fee in the amount of \$223 and amends the Public Safety (Fire) Schedule of fees set forth in Resolution 2021-192 to include the new fee.

Section 2. The new Non-Emergency Lift Assistance fee adopted by this resolution shall be effective March 1, 2022.
