RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN  
ADOPTING BROWN ACT TELECONFERENCE PROCEDURES DURING THE  
STATE'S PROCLAMATION OF AN EMERGENCY RELATED TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, pursuant to Government Code section 8625, the Governor of the State of California proclaimed a state of emergency to exist in California, as a result of the threat of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's proclamation of a state of emergency from the threat of COVID-19 has not been terminated; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Public Health and the Director and State Public Health Officer continue to recommend measures to promote physical (social) distancing to decrease the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, recently enacted amendments to the Brown Act, Government Code section 54950 et seq., allow local governments to use teleconferencing for public meetings during the state of emergency related to COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct.

Section 2. The City Council has reconsidered the circumstances of the current state of emergency proclaimed by the Governor related to COVID-19, and observes the proclamation has not been terminated and state public health authorities continue to recommend measures to promote physical (social) distancing to decrease the spread of COVID-19.

Section 3. The City Council hereby approves the City's use of teleconference procedures set forth in Government Code section 54953(e), for all City meetings, including but not limited to meetings of the City Council, City boards, commissions, committees, and task forces, during the State's proclamation of an emergency related to COVID-19.

Section 3. This resolution shall be in effect immediately, and reviewed every 30 days thereafter.
