RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR AGUILAR ROAD IMPROVEMENT DESIGN AND RELATED
SERVICES TO DOKKEN ENGINEERING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Aguilar Road Improvement Project consists of roadway reconstruction, installation of curb and gutter along with a pedestrian and bike path between China Garden Road and Greenbrae Road in the City of Rocklin; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposals for the Aguilar Road Improvements design services, and it was advertised on November 12, 2021, and November 19, 2021, with a proposal submittal date of December 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City received six (6) proposals which were evaluated and ranked with the top three (3) moving forward to interviews on January 27, 2022 and January 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, DOKKEN Engineering identified as the firm with the proposal most advantageous to the City, and staff recommends the City Council approve a contract for design and related services with DOKKEN Engineering in an amount not to exceed \$572,747; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded with SB325 Gas Tax funds (210) in the amount of \$150,00 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021/22 budget for this project; and

WHEREAS, a budget appropriation may be necessary to source additional funding from the SB325 Gas Tax Funds (210).

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Rocklin awards the contract for Aguilar Road Improvement design and related services to DOKKEN Engineering, and authorizes the City manager to execute an Agreement with DOKKEN Engineering in an amount not to exceed \$572,747, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
