RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN  
APPROVING THE PLACER COUNTY 2021 LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN  
UPDATE AND APPROVING AN AMENDMENT OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN GENERAL PLAN  
COMMUNITY SAFETY ELEMENT TO INCORPORATE BY REFERENCE THE PLACER COUNTY 2021  
LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE  
(GPA2022-0001)

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (“Disaster Mitigation Act”) emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, an adopted Local Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this local hazard mitigation plan; and

WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region IX officials have reviewed the Placer County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the Placer County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan by reference into the Community Safety Element of the General Plan in accordance with the requirements of California AB 2140, Government Code sections 8685.9 and 65302.6; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the governing body for the City of Rocklin demonstrates the jurisdiction’s commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in this Local Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this resolution legitimizes the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Rocklin adopts the Placer County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan. A true and correct copy of the Placer County 2021 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan Update is incorporated herein by reference, and available for review as set forth in Exhibit “A,” attached hereto.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Rocklin adopts the Placer County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan by reference into the Community Safety Element of their General Plan, in accordance with the requirements of California AB 2140, Government Code sections 8685.9 and 65302.6. A true and correct copy of the City of Rocklin General Plan Community Safety Element as amended, is incorporated herein by reference, and available for review as set forth in Exhibit “B,” attached hereto.

Section 4. The City Council of the City of Rocklin rescinds and replaces Table E-39 Rocklin General Plan Community Safety Element Goals and Policies of Annex E of the LHMP with the Community Safety Element Goals and Policies language attached hereto as Exhibit “C” and incorporated herein, which was adopted by the City Council of the City of Rocklin by Resolution 2021-154.

Section 5. The City Council of the City of Rocklin authorizes the City Manager to take such other actions as may be necessary to implement the purpose of this Resolution.

Section 6. The City Council of the City of Rocklin will submit this adoption resolution to the California Office of Emergency Services and FEMA Region IX officials to enable the plan’s final approval in accordance with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and to establish conformance with the requirements of California AB 2140, Government Code sections 8685.9 and 65302.6.
