RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS FOR LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 AND SETTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR PUBLIC HEARING THEREON

WHEREAS, pursuant to Division 15, Part 2 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, being known as the "Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972" ("the Act"), the City Council of the City of Rocklin has formed a Maintenance District that is known and designated as:

LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 (hereinafter referred to as the "Maintenance District"); and

WHEREAS, there has been presented and approved by the City Council of the City of Rocklin the Engineer's Report on the levy of the annual assessment for fiscal year 2022/23, as required by the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The above recitals are all true and correct.
- Section 2. The public interest and convenience requires, and it is the intention of this City Council to levy and collect annual assessments for the continual maintenance of street lighting and traffic signals for fiscal year 2022/23, all to serve and benefit the Maintenance District as said area is shown and delineated on a map approved by this City Council and which is on file in the office of the City Clerk, and open to public inspection. The map so referenced is hereby incorporated herein.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The proposed maintenance work within the area to be assessed shall be for certain existing street lighting and traffic signal improvements. No new improvements or substantial changes to existing improvements are proposed.
- <u>Section 4.</u> Reference is made to the Engineer's Report on file with the City Clerk and open to public inspection for a full and detailed description of the boundaries of the assessment District and the zones therein, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the District.
- <u>Section 5.</u> Neither the amount of the proposed assessment nor the approved methodologies for calculating the assessment for each parcel is proposed to be increased from the 2021/22 fiscal year.

<u>Section 6.</u> Any lots or parcels of land owned by a federal or state governmental agency or other local agency shall not be subject to assessment.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT TUESDAY, JUNE 14, 2022, AT THE HOUR OF 6:00 P.M., IN THE ROCKLIN CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 3970 ROCKLIN ROAD, ROCKLIN, CALIFORNIA, BEING THE REGULAR MEETING PLACE OF SAID CITY COUNCIL, IS THE TIME AND PLACE FIXED BY THIS CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE HEARING OF PROTESTS OR OBJECTIONS IN REFERENCE TO THE LEVY OF THE PROPOSED ASSESSMENT, AND ANY OTHER MATTERS CONTAINED IN THIS RESOLUTION. ANY PERSON WHO WISHES TO OBJECT TO THE LEVY OF ASSESSMENTS FOR STREET LIGHTING MAY APPEAR.

<u>Section 8.</u> The City Clerk is hereby directed to publish a Notice of Public Hearing in the Placer Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, not less than ten (10) days before the date of said public hearing.
