



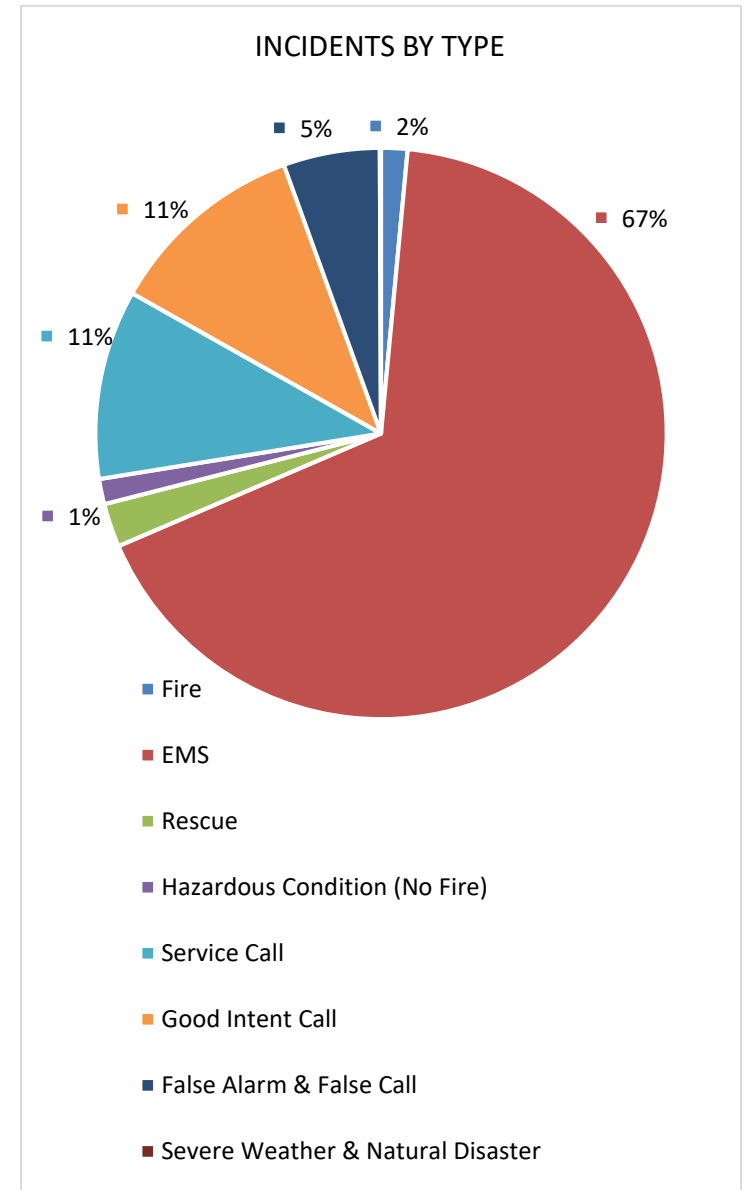

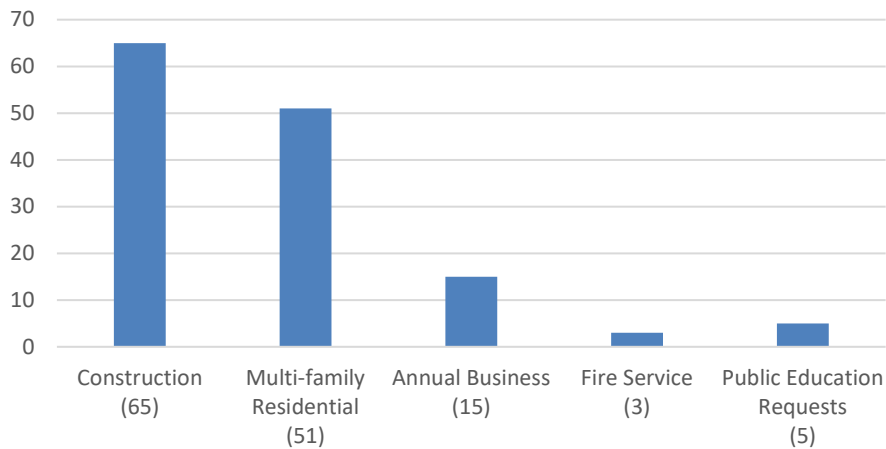

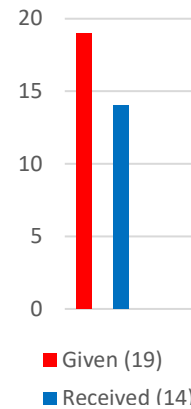

1/7/22	Structure Fire	2500 Block of S. Whitney Blvd.	Garage fire extended to house and adjoining unit (Duplex).	2 nd Alarm structure fire with six occupants displaced. Total loss of duplex structure with no injuries to residents or firefighters.
1/15/22	Structure Fire	5400 Block of Thunder Ridge Cir.	Room and contents 2 nd floor report of child still in residence.	Fire contained to 2 nd floor of home. Child rescued prior to fire department arrival.
1/31/22	Structure Fire	4600 Block of Arrowhead Dr.	Working house fire. Reported rescue of elderly male and 9 y/o child. Occupants found not in the house. No injuries.	Fire contained to building of origin. Total content loss.
3/28/22	Structure Fire	4300 Block of Longview Dr.	Fire in attack of home.	Contained to attic. No injuries. Two occupants and one pet displaced.
3/31/22	Structure Fire	6228 Brookside Cir.	Garage on fire.	Contained to garage, three occupants and one dog displaced
