RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF DUAL BAND RADIOS FROM MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS INC.

WHEREAS, neighboring law enforcement agencies in Placer County and Sacramento use a variety of UHF and VHF radio frequencies, however, the Rocklin Police Department is limited to use of VHF frequencies with its current radios, and in order to communicate with neighboring agencies, Rocklin officers need a dual band radio which allow them to switch between VHF and UHF frequencies; and

WHEREAS, the City recently was awarded a Homeland Security Grant, through the Placer County Office of Emergency Services in the amount of \$87,457. The City anticipates using \$84,504 of the FY 2020/21 DHS/OES grant for the purchase of ten additional dual band radios; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds do not provide the Rocklin Police Department with a sufficient inventory to equip all officers with a dual band radio, and the purchase of 23 additional dual band radios is necessary; and

WHEREAS, in December 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2021-242, setting aside fiscal year 2020/21 surplus funding of \$186,902 for the purpose of co-purchasing a Police Tactical Unit Vehicle that would be shared with Roseville Police Department and subsequently, it was determined Rocklin funds are no longer necessary for that purchase; and

WHEREAS, staff recommend redirecting said funds for the purchase of twenty-three dual band radios from Motorola Solutions Inc., to complete the outfitting of dual band radios for all officers, and amending the budget to reflect the repurposing of the funds with the approval of the quarterly financial report at a future Council meeting; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the City purchase the additional 33 (total) dual band radios from Motorola Solutions Inc. through the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to purchase 33 dual band radios from Motorola Solutions Inc. through the HGAC Cooperative Purchasing program, in an amount not to exceed \$270,630.

Section 2. The following appropriations are approved:

A. The Police Tactical Unit replacement funding of \$186,902 reserved in the General Fund balance will be redirected for the purchase of 23 dual band radios.

- B. \$186,902 will be appropriated in the FY 2021/22 expenditure budget from the General Fund Balance, for the purchase of 23 dual band radios from Motorola Inc.
- C. Appropriate the revenue and expenditure budgets of \$87,457 (Traffic Safety/Police Grant Fund, Fund No. 244) in the FY 2021/22 budget with the acceptance of the 2021 HSG/OES grant.
- D. \$84,504 of HSG/OES 2021 grant funds will be used for the purchase of 10 dual band radios from Motorola Inc.
