## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-**

## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN ORDERING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS FOR LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 2 AND CONFIRMING A DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rocklin has formed a lighting maintenance district pursuant to the terms and provisions of Part 2, Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, known and designated as: LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 2 (hereinafter referred to as the "Maintenance District"); and

WHEREAS, this City Council has ordered the preparation of an engineer's report ("Report") (Resolution No. 2022-89), and the Report was prepared and filed with this City Council pursuant to law for its consideration and, subsequently thereto, this City Council did approve said Report (Resolution No. 2022-90) and adopt a Resolution of Intention to order the levy and collection of assessments in said Maintenance District as set forth in said Report and, further, did proceed to give notice of the time and place for public hearing on the question of the levy of the proposed assessment (Resolution No. 2022-91); and

WHEREAS, following a public hearing on June 14, 2022, the City Council has heard all testimony and evidence and is desirous of proceeding with the levying of assessments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

- Section 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The City Council hereby orders the services and maintenance work to be done as set forth in the Report as approved, and orders the levy and collection of the assessments as shown and set forth and described in said Report.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The diagram and assessment, as set forth and contained in said Report, are hereby confirmed and adopted.
- <u>Section 4</u>. The adoption of this Resolution constitutes the levy of the maintenance assessment for the Fiscal Year commencing July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023.

<u>Section 5</u>. That the City Treasurer shall place in that special fund known as the: "LANDSCAPE AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 2" all monies collected by the Tax Collector pursuant to the provisions of this Resolution and law and said transfer shall be made and accomplished as soon as said monies have been made available to said City Treasurer.

<u>Section 6</u>. City staff are hereby ordered and directed to file a certified copy of the diagram and assessment roll with the Placer County Auditor together with a certified copy of this Resolution upon its adoption.

<u>Section 7</u>. A certified copy of this Resolution constituting the levy of the maintenance assessment for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023, shall be on file in the office of the City Clerk with Resolution No. 2022-90 and open for public inspection.
