RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN  
AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE ADA RAMPS & CONCRETE SERVICES PROJECT TO  
PBM CONSTRUCTION, INC. AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE  
AGREEMENT WITH PBM CONSTRUCTION, INC.

WHEREAS, the ADA ramps and concrete services project (“Project”) consists of the construction/retrofit of ADA ramps and concrete services such as the construction of sidewalks, and concrete flatwork throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the invitation for bids on the Project was advertised July 9, 2022, and July 16, 2022, with bids opened on July 25, 2022, examined and found to be in compliance with all applicable specifications; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bid was submitted by PBM Construction, Inc. at \$378,673, and staff recommends that the contract for the Project be awarded to PBM Construction, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the total bid amount of \$378,673 was for bidding purposes only, the contract for the Project is for an amount not to exceed \$200,000 annually; and

WHEREAS, there is no additional fiscal impact as the funds for these services are included in the FY 2022/23 Budget under CDBG – HUD Entitlement Grant (257); and

WHEREAS, staff seek Council’s approval and authorization to allow the City Manager to renew the contract on the same terms, for up to two additional one-year terms, for a total contract term of two years and ten months, and a maximum not to exceed amount of \$600,000, subject to Council’s future appropriation of funds for the services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City Council awards the contract for the ADA Ramps and Concrete Services to PBM Construction, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement with PBM Construction Inc. for the Project, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A.”

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to renew the Agreement with PBM Construction, Inc. for the Project on the same terms, for two additional one-year

terms, provided sufficient funding for the services has been budgeted and appropriated.
