RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
APPROVING EXPENDITURE OF CORONAVIRUS STATE AND LOCAL
FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS FOR THE LIGHTHOUSE COUNSELING AND
FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER'S PROVISION OF MENTAL AND
BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SUPPORT SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING THE
CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
LIGHTHOUSE COUNSELING AND FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER

WHEREAS, the Federal Government allocated \$350 billion from the American Rescue Plan Act for the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds which allocated funding to state, local, and Tribal governments to support the response to and recovery from COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin has received \$7,039,025 in funding from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds; and

WHEREAS, American Rescue Plan Act funding is intended to mitigate the negative impact of COVID-19 on local communities; and

WHEREAS, at the May 10, 2022 Rocklin City Council meeting the City Council approved spending American Rescue Plan Act Funding for mental health support programs for Rocklin residents, and,

WHEREAS, the Lighthouse Counseling and Family Resource Center has submitted a proposal for use of City of Rocklin Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds for mental and/or behavioral health support services, and staff has determined the proposal meets Federal Guidelines for allowable American Rescue Plan Act funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Rocklin approves and authorizes the expenditure of City of Rocklin Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds for the provision of mental and/or behavioral health support services by the Lighthouse Counseling and Family Resource Center.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Rocklin authorizes the City Manager to execute an Agreement with the Lighthouse Consulting and Family Resource Center for the provision of mental and/or behavioral health support services in an amount not to exceed \$215,000, in a form approved by the City Attorney.
