RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
APPROVING CHANGES TO THE SALARY RANGES FOR THE
DEPUTY FIRE CHIEF AND POLICE CAPTAIN CLASSIFICATIONS,
AND ADOPTING REVISED MANAGEMENT SALARY SCHEDULES

WHEREAS, the City's Human Resources Division conducted a compaction analysis for the Deputy Fire Chief and Police Captain classifications; and

WHEREAS, Human Resources determined the compaction analysis demonstrated compaction between the highest-level subordinate classifications and the Deputy Fire Chief and the Police Captain classifications.

WHEREAS, Human Resources recommends the salary range for Deputy Fire Chief be changed from management salary range 30 (\$132,490-\$182,639 annually) to new management salary range 31 (\$135,802-\$187,205 annually), and the salary range for Police Captain be changed from management salary range 33 (\$142,677-\$196,682 annually) to new management salary range 35 (\$149,900-\$206,639), effective September 24, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rocklin as follows:

Section 1. The salary range for the classification of Deputy Fire Chief shall be adjusted from management salary range 30 to new management salary range 31, effective September 24, 2022, as reflected in the Management Salary Schedules attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 2. The salary range for the classification of Deputy Fire Chief shall be adjusted from management salary range 33 to new management salary range 35, effective September 24, 2022, as reflected in the Management Salary Schedules attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 3. The City Council approves and adopts the Management Salary Schedules attached hereto as Exhibit "A," effective September 24, 2022.
