RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH
THE FLOCK GROUP INC. TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER
CAMERA SERVICES

WHEREAS, since 2019 the City of Rocklin has incorporated Automated License Plate Reader cameras within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Rocklin Police Department previously adopted a policy pertaining to the use of Automated License Plate Readers, and the public has been provided an opportunity to comment on the use of Automated License Plate Readers at City Council meetings, in compliance with California Civil Code section 1798.90.5, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Rocklin Police Department intends to expand the Automated License Plate Reader system to cover most ingress and egress roads; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the City enter into a two-year Services Agreement with the Flock Group Inc. to lease 32 Automated License Plate Reader Cameras that will be installed and serviced by Flock Group Inc.; and

WHEREAS, funding for the first year of service, \$94,700, will be funded from the State Asset Forfeiture funds (Fund 242) and necessitates budget amendment in Fund 242.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The Flock Group Inc. Services Agreement for the installation, lease, and servicing of 32 Automated License Plate Reader Cameras is approved, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibits "A," and "B."

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute said Services Agreement with Flock Group Inc. for Automated License Plate Reader Cameras, for a two-year term, in a total amount not to exceed \$178,200.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to increase the fiscal year 2022/23 expenditure budget by \$94,700 in the State Asset Forfeiture Fund (Fund 242) from the fund balance of Fund 242.
