


Below is a summary for the Rocklin Police Department crime rate and performance for 1/1/22 - 07/31/22.

Crime Rate and Trends

- Crime rate is currently 9.2, an increase of 0% from the same time period last year.
 - Total part 1 crime increased 1%
 - Total violent crime decreased 10%
 - Total property crime increased 2%
 - Shoplifting increased 28%
 - Theft from vehicles decreased 10%





Crime Summary

Overall crime rate in the City of Rocklin has increased 0% to 9.2 crimes per 1,000 residents from the same time period last year. Total part 1 crimes increased by 1% (+4). Violent crime decreased 10% (-6). Property crime increased 2% due to increases in reported larceny. Total larceny increased 6% (+26) with theft from vehicles decreasing 10% (-25) and shoplifting increasing 28% (+15). Catalytic converter thefts (which are included in the totals of larceny - theft from vehicle) continue to be an issue, not just Citywide, but in the region.


Total police incidents decreased 1% (-312), with calls for service decreasing 3% (-576) and officer initiated activity increasing 2% (+264). Overall arrests increased 21% (+119), with felony increasing 32% (+56) and misdemeanor increasing 15% (+63).

Total traffic collisions across the City decreased 15% for a net decrease of 38 collisions from the previous 2021 time period. Overall, injury collisions increased 18% (+10) and non-injury collisions decreased 25% (-48). Citations written decreased 4%.
