

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CONSOLIDATED GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF
ROCKLIN ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022, FOR TWO COUNCILMEMBERS FOR FULL (FOUR-YEAR) TERMS
AND MEASURE F, THE TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX MEASURE

WHEREAS, a Consolidated General Election was held and conducted in the City of Rocklin, County of Placer, State of California, on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2022, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 2022-151 adopted on June 28, 2022, the Placer County's Election Office canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results are received, as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the City for the Member of City Council – Full Term was 33,820.

Section 2. The names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City Council – Full Term are as follows:

William "Bill" Halldin
Jill Gayaldo

Section 3. In accordance with California Elections Code section 10262, the City Clerk has certified the results of the election to the City Council. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given to each of the persons above named for the office of Member of City Council – Full Term are as follows:

William "Bill" Halldin	17,900	52.93%
Jill Gayaldo	15,920	47.07%

Section 4. The City Council does declare and determine that William "Bill" Halldin and Jill Gayaldo are elected as Members of the City Council for the full term of four years.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City of Rocklin, a statement of the results of the election showing: (1) the whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons voted for Member of the City Council (full term); and (3) the total number of votes given to each person.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

Section 7. The proposed City of Rocklin’s Transient Occupancy Tax Measure was included on the ballot:

Section 8. The total number of votes (ballots) cast in the City for Measure F was 28,251.

Section 9. In accordance with California Elections Code section 10262, the City Clerk has certified the results of the tax measure. The number of votes given for the above tax measure both for and against are as follows:

YES	16,713	58.60%
NO	11,808	41.40%

Section 10. The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election, a majority of the voters voting on Measure F did vote in favor thereof, and Measure F has been approved.

Section 11. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City of Rocklin, a statement of the results of the election showing: (1) the whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the City for the measure voted upon.
